

Establishment of International Course

New International Education Program by English Immersion approach will start in 2026 at Elementary School Attached to the Faculty of Education, Kumamoto University.

In the International Course, almost all classes except for some subjects such as Japanese and moral education, will be taught in well-balanced foreign and native languages (English Immersion Education*) in accordance with the Curriculum Standards (Courses of Study) in Japan. During our English immersion education, both growth of linguistic abilities (e.g. linking experiences and language, reading and thinking logically, and basic learning activities) and comprehension of each subject are expected. Particularly, due to class system of joint learning by Japanese and international students together, children's listening and speaking skills in both languages will naturally develop through learning and campus life.

In addition, team-teaching consisting of Japanese teachers and English native instructors are planned in every class, therefore necessary support in Japanese will also be provided to deepen the students' understanding of the learning contents.

*According to educational principles and plans of the Elementary School Attached to the Faculty of Education, Kumamoto University, the English Immersion Education is explained as the approach of using the target language as the medium through which curricular content is conveyed, to help the learners not only to strength their ability of the native language (English and Japanese) and the understanding lesson subjects, but also to acquire the proficiency in the target language and linguistic abilities in the immersion environment.

■ Contributing to the Global Human Resources

One of our aims of this program is to develop an excellent next-generation as future global human resources who can be cooperative with diverse people and creative to solve diverse problem with the advanced linguistic abilities and problem-solving skills.

■ Contributing to the Local Community

As the only affiliated school of a national university in Kumamoto, we contribute to the development of local education through the promotion of the English immersion education in public schools in the near future as another mission of our program.

The Roadmap for Establishing an International Program(draft)




